2015-16 Authorization to Retain Title IV Funds

In compliance with federal regulations, it is the policy of Carey Business School to apply a student's Title IV federal financial aid funds to current qualifying charges (tuition and mandatory fees) incurred for the current academic year. Carey Business School provides each student with a credit balance check if the disbursement of Title IV federal financial aid creates a credit balance on the student's account for that payment period. Any student who has a past due balance may not enroll in the next term until that balance has been paid.
