



APA TITLE PAGE

The title page is the first page of your paper and tells your professor:

- The title of your paper
- Your name
- Your university

EXAMPLE

Running Head

An abbreviated title in all caps is placed flush left preceded by the words "Running head."

Running head: FACULTY VIEWS UNIVERSITY	1
An Empirical Study of College of Education Faculty's Perceptions, Beliefs, and Commitments to the Teaching of Diversity Jane Smith University of Miami	

Page Numbers

Start with page one on the title page.

Identifying Information

About half-way down the page, include the paper's title, your name, and your school. Center and double space this info. Do not include the date, class, or professor name unless your professor specifies otherwise.
