

## Part-time Program Cost - Academic Year 2022-2023

This handout should be used by US Citizens and Permanent Residents (those students eligible for federal financial aid).

Tuition for part-time programs is charged per credit. The rate is based on the term in which students begin their program.

Fall 2021 and Later	\$1,730
Fall 2020/Spring 2021/Summer 2021	\$1,675
Prior to Fall 2020	\$1,600

## Part-time Tuition based on Enrollment Status

Students must enroll at least half-time in order to receive federal aid.

Prior to Fall 2020	Summer Tuition	Fall/Spring
Half-time	\$6,400 (4 credits)	\$9,600 (6 credits)
Three-quarter time	\$9,600 (6 credits)	\$12,800 (8 credits)
Full-time	\$12,800 (8 credits)	\$16,000 (10 credits)

<sup>\*</sup>The federal direct loan currently has a 1.057% origination fee. The net amount on \$20,500 is \$20,284.

- The federal direct loan is offered each academic year and students need to apply for aid each year. Your loans are divided evenly across all semesters in which you plan enrollment. Graduate students are eligible for \$20,500 each academic year. The current interest rate is 5.28% but is reset each July 1. You will need to complete a Master Promissory Note and Entrance Counseling for this loan at <a href="https://studentaid.gov/h/complete-aid-process">https://studentaid.gov/h/complete-aid-process</a>.

## Other Assistance:

**Employer Tuition Assistance** - Remission or Reimbursement from your employer.

<u>Federal Graduate PLUS Loan</u> - students can borrow up to their cost of attendance less any other aid. This loan requires a credit check. Apply for the GradPLUS loan online at <a href="https://studentaid.gov/plus-app/grad/landing">https://studentaid.gov/plus-app/grad/landing</a>. There is a 4.228% origination fee on this loan. The current interest rate is 6.28% (reset each July 1).

Other Outside Assistance - outside scholarships and other aid students search for and receive on their own.

<u>Private/Alternative Loans</u> - educational loans borrowed through a private bank.
