## Leadership Development Program to Master of Science in Business Analytics and Risk Management (Part-Time)

How do I apply for MS in Business Analytics and Risk Management (Part-Time)? You will apply as a current student adding a program. To apply, go to:

- 2. Click "Identify your Status", Select "Current Carey Student"
- 3. Click "Continue"
- 4. Select new program you are applying to, term, and location
- 5. Complete the application with any necessary documentation as requested

When will the application be available for Fall? The application for each new cycle opens in September every year.

What are the admissions requirements? All applicants are considered in the same way. We primarily review work experience, grade point averages, and letters of recommendation.
