

Curriculum Vitae for Ko Wang

Professor Ko Wang is Professor and Clayton Emory Chair in Real Estate and Infrastructure at the Carey Business School of the Johns Hopkins University. Prior to the JHU appointment, he was Professor and Newman Chair in Real Estate Finance and the founding Chair of the Department of Real Estate at the Zicklin School of Business of Baruch College. He also served as the Chaired Professor of Real Estate and the founding Director of the School of Hotel Management at the Chinese University of Hong Kong. Ko is the editor of the *Journal of Real Estate Research* (official journal of the American Real Estate Society) since 1998, the founding co-executive editor of *International Real Estate Review* (official journal of the Asian Real Estate Society), and the founding co-executive editor of the *Journal of Real Estate* (in Chinese, the official journal of the Global Chinese Real Estate Congress). Ko chaired the founding meeting of the Asian Real Estate Society in 1996 and had served as its Executive Director until 2002. He also chaired the founding meeting of the Global Chinese Real Estate Congress in 2008 and has served as its Secretary-General since then. Ko publishes extensively in top-tier real estate and finance journals (including *Journal of Finance*, *Journal of Financial Economics*, *Review of Financial Studies*, *Journal of Financial and Quantitative Analysis*, *Journal of Business*, *Journal of Urban Economics*, *Real Estate Economics*, *Journal of Real Estate Research*, and *Journal of Real Estate Finance and Economics*), co-authored a book on Real Estate Investment Trusts (Oxford University Press: New York), and co-wrote 21 teaching cases and teaching notes on real estate and finance issues faced by firms in Asia (distributed by Harvard Business School Publishing and European Case Clearing House). He obtained a Ph.D. degree in Finance and Real Estate, an MBA degree and an MS in Community and Regional Planning degree from the University of Texas at Austin.
